
# **Stripping Tools**



Choose the right Stripping Tool for your needs.

### **Key Features**

- Hand Stripper crimps conductor portions insulated terminals and splices.
- Multi-Strip has long life cutting blades.
- Fiber Strip has a recessed cutting surface for long runs of cords.

## **Hand Stripper**

The Hand Stripper produces crimps in two color-coded cavities. Red 16-22 AWG and Blue 14-16 AWG crimps are made in the front cavity. Yellow 10-12 AWG crimps are made in the rear cavity (closest to the pivot). The Stripper can crimp noninsulated terminals and splices.

It can cut five different machine screw sizes—4-40, 6-32, 8-32, 10-24, and 10-32. Countersunk and threaded screw pockets provide easy entry, and the cutter is located near the pivot to provide a clean sheer without distorting the screw threads.

#### Multi-Strip

This tool slits and strips twisted-pair cable and strips flat satin cable. It is made of highly visible and durable Derlin SuperTuff.

It has a long life cutting blade and variable strip and slit lengths to accommadate different connector requirements. And strip length reference surfaces are provided for all cable types.

#### Fiber Strip

This tool is used to prepare cords before connection. It slits duplex and quad cords, stripping the jacket to expose the aramid yarn in the process, and then strips the buffer to expose the glass fiber.

It also has a long-life cutting blade and variable strip and slit lengths. A recessed cutting surface slits long runs of duplex and quad cords.
